

How to legally change your name in the UNITED NUWAUBIAN NATION OF MOORS

You may wish to change your name for one of many reasons -- you may have gotten married or divorced, for example, or you may simply dislike your birth name. If you are a **citizen** of the **UNITED NUWAUBIAN NATION OF MOORS**, you may petition the **U.N.N.M.** to legally change your name. Your eligibility for a name change is governed by **U.N.N.M. law**. After you complete your name change, you will have to amend your state identity documents to reflect the change.

Step 1

Fill out a **19-3 Petition for Name Change**. You can request this form asking for it by email @ **info@unnm.org**. The petition requires you to reveal your current name, your desired name, your address, your date of birth and your reason for wanting your name changed. Sign and date the petition.

Step 2

File your petition with the Nuwaubian Nation Court. Include a copy of your birth certificate along with a copy of any documents, such as a marriage certificate, that established your reason for wanting to change your name.

Step 3

Inform and submit to the Nuwaubian Nation Court the reason why you would like to change your legal name.

Step 4

Attend or appear a name change hearing at the **Nuwaubian Nation Court** in person or by live video feed. The court will notify you of the hearing date. The date will be more than 30 days after you filed your petition. **The MAKU** may question you to ensure that your name change complies with **U.N.N.M. law**. **You cannot** change your name for the purpose of evading creditors or escaping criminal liability. **You cannot** change your name to a racial slur or obscenity, and **you cannot** change your name to a name that would confuse people. Lastly **You cannot** change your name to the name of a famous person if circumstances indicate your intention is to mislead people.

Step 5

Notify the **U.N.N.M. authorities** of your name change. These authorities include the **NUWAUBIAN MOOR STATE** and or **CAPITAL** Administration in which you reside.

Things Needed:

Petition for Name Change **19-3**.

Certified copy of your birth certificate.

Evidence of the reason for your name change (such as your marriage certificate).

Filing fee: **\$250.00 USD** in a Cashier's Check or Postal Money Order.

Notice & Warnings

If you are under 18, a qualified adult must file the petition on your behalf -- your adoptive parent, for example, if you are changing your name due to adoption.
